JANUARY PAINTING PROJECT – taught by LES TRYON

Attention Ladies: In January we are going to have fun. Doxie Keller has graciously allowed us to use her so cute design for a new paint shirt or apron. Sharron Jones taught this at CODA and has assisted me in putting this information together. I used a lab coat which I purchased from a uniform shop. The fabric can have some polyester with the cotton. You need a thinner fabric which you can see thru as this is how you apply the pattern. Wash your surface using plain unscented detergent, no bleach, dry and use no fabric softener. This is a no stress project and color choice is limited only by your imagination. I will bring the pattern that day. If you already have the pattern – DO NOT PUT IT ON YOUR SHIRT/APRON. It is a sassy trio of lovely ladies all ready for a day of shopping or lunch at the tea room.

If some of you could bring an iron and portable ironing board-you know you don't need it at home!
Identipen-only brand that will not bleed - I will have some for sale at the meeting.

Fabric brushes - whatever you have

Freezer paper - I will have some

Shirt board

Masking tape

Decoart Transparent Medium - I will have some

Suggested colors but you can bring any Decoart Fabric paint you have---

Black, Warm neutral, ultra white, cadmium yellow, antique gold, dark rose, dark burgundy, primary blue, indian turquoise, christmas green apply green. Sparkly colors are encouraged.

There are just the suggested colors-bring what you have and share with your neighbor in class. It is so much fun to give your lady lime green hair or hot pink boots. Polka dots, stripes and sparkly earrings - who can resist?

Civitan Club House Directions, Glendale Street, Durham, NC, Phone: (919) 220-8346

From Raleigh – Get on 70 toward Durham. 70 becomes 85 S at some point in Durham. Follow 85S and take the Duke St. exit. Go right on Duke St. (north). At the first light (Leon Street) turn right [Leon Street becomes Glendale.] Go about 1/2 mile and start watching for the clubhouse on the left. It is below street level, and in a residential area, so you have to keep your eye out. It's not hard to find--you just have to watch for it. It is the Friendly City Civitan Club.

From 40W – You can get to 70 by crossing over at 540 or Miami Blvd. Follow the above directions.

From Chapel Hill – You can follow 15-501 and get on 85N. Take the Duke St. exit and head north. Follow the directions above.

From 40E – Get on 85N and follow the above directions. The Durham Expressway will also get you there.
